THIS WEEK'S LESSON: FAITH SPINNERS



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Sometimes life can feel like it's spinning us out of control! No one had a life that spun from good to bad to worse quite like Joseph. But Joseph never lost his faith, and God blessed Joseph. Genesis 41:14-27, 41-43, Pharaoh and Joseph



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

If you have some fidget spinners at home, take some time to play with them with the kids. Test how easy it is to start and stop the spinning. Then talk with the kids about what we can do when our life is spinning out of control.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- How did Joseph's life spin out of control?
- How did God turn things around for Joseph?
- Why do we need to hold onto God when life is spinning out of control?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:
