### THIS WEEK'S LESSON: BACK TO SCHOOL BIBLE VERSES



#### IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Kids may face difficult situations in the coming school year. These three Bible verses remind us to have courage; to do everything as if we are doing it for God, and that we can do all things through Christ who gives us strength. Joshua 1:9, Colossians 3:23, Philippians 4:13



#### HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

When you help the kids pack up their school supplies, quiz them on the three verses above.



#### AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Where can we get courage when we need it?
- Why should we do everything, even homework, as if we were doing it for God?
- How can God give us strength to do all things?



#### AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

*"I can do everything by the power of Christ. He gives me strength." Philippians 4:13 (NIV)*



#### PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

Every school year brings new challenges. We don't know what those challenges will be, but we can prepare our children by praying for them and with them as well as encouraging them to hide the Word of God in their hearts. Memorize these verses with your kids, and a few weeks down the line, quiz them to see if they stuck!
